

Cargo advice from Swedish Club

In collaboration with the cargo experts at CWA International, The Swedish Club has produced cargo advice to assist its members in the daily operation of their vessels.

This month the club has highlighted refrigerated cargo advice. It noted that a wide variety of refrigerated goods were carried in reefer containers, of which fresh produce, frozen meat & fish, dairy products and pharmaceuticals were only a few.

The Club said that a single reefer container could carry a cargo value of several hundred thousand US dollars or more, noting that refrigerated cargoes were one of the most common types of cargoes involved in cargo claims. “Each type of cargo varies in its requirements for carriage temperature, humidity, stowage arrangements and ventilation. By adhering to the recommendations given in the advice, the risk of suffering a claim will be reduced”, the club said. Further details at:
